"I have come to know Stephanie through my own work in my constituency of Cardiff North. I knew she was busy, but it was only when I started to list all the things that she does that I realised just how much she gives back to her community. I know of four posts that she holds: Chair of Llandaff North Residents Association, Friends of Hailey Park, Save Hawthorn Rd. School Campaign and the Melingriffth Water Wheel Project. That is enough to keep her very busy.

"In my dealings with her, Stephanie has never once offered the fact that she does so much. It is this sort of modesty that typifies the work that many people do.

"These receptions serve to remind everyone of all the good work that is going on in the community. We will never know about everything that goes on, so we will never be able to invite everybody, but I feel that this type of event is a tribute to everyone who does something and it acknowledges the part they play in our society."
