JULIE MORGAN MP GIVES SUPPORT TO CIVIL SERVANTS AT COMPANIES HOUSE

Julie Morgan, MP for Cardiff North, after visiting Companies House in Gabalfa, has praised the staff and management at Companies House for their achievements in modernising the system for keeping records of all the companies in the UK.

Julie Morgan MP said:

“I was very impressed by the achievements of everyone at Companies House.”

Julie Morgan MP also met the PCS union representatives and discussed the ongoing dispute over the Civil Service Compensation Scheme and the government’s plans to change the entitlement to redundancy payments. PCS is currently balloting for industrial action.

Julie Morgan MP said:

“I believe further efforts must be made to move towards a settlement that will protect all PCS members in the event of redundancy. The government has made concessions, but it needs to go further.

“The new arrangements will protect everyone up to £20,000, but those above are not protected. Also, some long-serving civil servants could lose up to 50% of what they had expected and others could lose 30% of what they had expected.

“I understand there is a need for expenditure to be cut, but I do not believe that existing conditions should be changed. The new proposals should apply to new entrants to the civil service only.”
