<p>THE WAR IN IRAQ</p> <p>I voted repeatedly against the war in Iraq.</p>	<p>ANIMAL WELFARE</p> <p>I voted for the fox hunting ban in 2004 and will continue to support it.</p>	<p>TOP-UP TUITION FEES</p> <p>I voted against top-up tuition fees in 2004.</p>	<p>NATIONAL MINIMUM WAGE</p> <p>I voted for the National Minimum Wage.</p>	<p>LLANISHEN RESERVOIR</p> <p>I have supported the cause of the residents from the beginning and support all the hard work that RAG has done.</p>
<p>SMOKING</p> <p>In 2005, I introduced a Private Member's Bill to ban smoking in public places in Wales and supported the introduction of the law in 2007.</p>	<p>OLDER PEOPLE</p> <p>I supported Pension Credits, the Winter Fuel Payment, free TV licences for the over-75s, free eye tests for the over-60s, and free bus passes.</p>	<p>CULTURE</p> <p>I strongly support free entry into national galleries and museums.</p>	<p>CLIMATE CHANGE</p> <p>I supported the 2008 Climate Change Act.</p>	<p>FAMILIES</p> <p>I supported increases in maternity leave and child benefit, the introduction of paternity leave, the right to request flexible working, tax credits and Child Trust Funds.</p>
<p>THE GURKHAS</p> <p>I supported the campaign for Gurkha Justice from the start and voted for their right to settle.</p>	<p>GAY RIGHTS</p> <p>I voted for Civil Partnerships and I supported the repeal of Section 28.</p>	<p>HOUSE of LORDS REFORM</p> <p>I think that there should be a second chamber, but that it should be totally elected.</p>	<p>TRIDENT</p> <p>I voted against replacing Trident in 2007.</p>	<p>AFGHANISTAN</p> <p>I believe that this is a war that cannot be won and that there will eventually have to be dialogue with part of the Taliban, but I always support our troops when they are in action.</p>
<p>CARDIFF BUS REORGANISATION</p> <p>I have fought against the reorganisation since bus services were altered. I petitioned for full consultation with bus users.</p>	<p>WELSH ASSEMBLY POWERS</p> <p>I support primary law making powers for the Welsh Assembly and I have always supported devolution.</p>	<p>WOMEN</p> <p>I supported the National Minimum Wage, stronger domestic violence legislation, the doubling of maternity pay, and the huge investment into childcare.</p>	<p>SUNBEDS BILL</p> <p>My Private Member's Bill to protect under-18s from the dangers of sunbeds was passed into law last month. I'm one of the few backbench MPs to have a Bill become law.</p>	<p>VOTING SYSTEMS</p> <p>I have always supported a fairer voting system and believe that we need a more proportionate system in Westminster.</p>
